Lasoski Opens Knoxville's 40th Season With Win

Knoxville, IA – Old timers are calling it one of the most exciting feature events ever staged at this Marion County half-mile facility. At the finish, Danny Lasoski nosed out Terry McCarl in a side by side crossing of the tape to conclude a 20-lap race which opened the 40th season of weekly racing at the Knoxville Raceway.

Lasoski, who started in the fifth row of the ten-mile event, had worked his way into the top five by lap five. With Danny Smith leading the pack, Jaymie Moyle, Lee Brewer Jr. and McCarl staged a furious battle for the top spot. Lap after lap saw each driver use every portion of the track to find an advantage as Lasoski began picking off one car after another.

When the red flag flew on lap thirteen for a Dennis Moore Jr. front chute endo, Lasoski had gained the runner-up position to Smith. McCarl held the third spot.

On the ensuing restart, McCarl surprised everyone as he shot around both front-running cars and grabbed the lead. The two drivers staged a furious battle while Smith awaited any miscue that might enable him to forge to the front.

As the laps began to run down, McCarl began to pull away and appeared to be on his way to a well-earned victory. When the cars entered the white flag lap, a yellow was displayed for a stalled car and a single-file restart of the field was aligned.

When the race resumed, Lasoski dove low and grabbed a tenuous lead in a side by side drag race to the finish. At the checkered, Lasoski pushed the C&S Enterprises Challenge to a \$2,500 win ahead of McCarl. It was the 36th feature event win at Knoxville for Lasoski. McCarl, Smith, Brewer Jr. and Moyle completed the top five finishers. Randy Smith, Brent Antill, Bob White, Kenny Hansen and Jerry Richert Jr. rounded out the top ten in the event.

Danny Young remained the hottest driver in the upper Midwest in the 360 c.i. sprint division as he claimed his fourth win in five outings. Young took the lead on the third lap after the race leader David Hesmer crashed in the second turn. Chad Radel, Dave Hollamon, Lee Nelson and John Gerloff completed the top five finishers. A total of seventy-one sprinters signed through the pit gate.

Lasoski Tops Kinser on Final Turn in WoO Knoxville Prelim

Knoxville, IA – Danny Lasoski proved the old adage that “Local Boy Makes Good” as he captured an exciting 20-lap feature event at the Knoxville Raceway during the World of Outlaws Spring Opener Friday night.

“I just wish this was the Nationals,” said a happy Lasoski in a jubilant victory lane celebration.

Lasoski, who started the feature event in the tenth spot, was able to pick off five positions after the race was just one lap old. Steve Kinser, who started on the pole, was in the process of jumping into a comfortable lead over Mark Kinser, and through the fifth lap that duo cruised the half-mile oval on the high side. Lasoski, by lap five, had forged his way to third place, but was running the lowest portion of the track.

Lasoski, the defending Knoxville Raceway track champion, completed a pass of Mark Kinser after the completion of twelve laps and the scene was set for a running down of Steve on the remaining circuits.

With five laps to go, Lasoski had pulled onto Kinser’s rear bumper and as the laps began to run down, it looked as the tough driver from Missouri would not be able to catch and pass the defending Knoxville Nationals champion.

On the white flag lap, Kinser maintained his momentum as he entered turns three and four on the high side. Lasoski took those same turns running down low, and as he shot out of the final curve, his sprinter had taken the lead with Kinser roaring out of that same corner for a drag race to the checkered flag. At the finish, Lasoski’s C&S Enterprises American Challenge crossed the finish line by about a half-car length over the Kinser mount for his 37th career win here at Knoxville.

Mark Kinser maintained his position for third, Kenny Jacobs took fourth, and Stevie Smith came on strong for fifth. Johnny Herrera, Dave Blaney, Jeff Swindell, Joe Gaerte and Jac Haudenschild completed the top ten finishers.

Everything's Coming Up Lasoski

Knoxville, IA – Danny Lasoski, driving the C&S Enterprises American Challenge, again used some late-race heroics to claim his third feature event win in a row at the Knoxville Raceway Saturday night. The defending track champion edged Terry McCarl and Stevie Smith at the checkered flag to gain the win and keep his record perfect at this Marion County half-mile oval.

Danny Smith grabbed the lead at the outset of the 20-lap feature but was passed by Smith on lap three. A yellow flag on lap seven for debris on the track bunched the cars for the restart and Lasoski, who had started eighth, had moved into the third spot and was challenging the leaders.

When the race resumed, Lasoski made a pass of Danny Smith and fell into line behind Stevie Smith. The twosome diced through lapped traffic with relative ease and utilized every portion of the track in doing so. However, Lasoski was never able to mount a threat or close the gap on the fleet front-running Smith.

By lap fifteen, Terry McCarl, who had started alongside Lasoski, had joined the fray. And with the laps running down, it looked as if the race would end with the top trio of cars unable to make any changes.

When John Hall looped his car and stalled in turn two of the white flag lap, the race again went yellow. On the single file restart, Lasoski dove low and passed a high riding Smith going into turns three and four. Lasoski maintained his position by the flagstand and around the final lap as McCarl too grabbed a position from Smith. The \$2,500 win was Lasoski's 38th at the Knoxville Raceway.

Danny Smith drove to fourth and Max Dumesny was fifth. Brent Antill, Tim Monson, Steve Beitler, Bob Weuve and Kevin Doty completed the top ten finishers.

In Knoxville 360 sprint action, Danny Young remained as hot as Lasoski as he garnered the feature event for that division. The win was Young's third here and his sixth in seven starts this season. Young took a ninth lap restart lead from David Hesmer to gain the win. Hesmer, Dwight Snodgrass, Billy Bell and Mike Twedt formed the top five finishers.

Lasoski Still Unbeaten at Knoxville

Knoxville, IA – Defending Knoxville Raceway track champion Danny Lasoski kept his record unblemished as he swept to two feature event wins Saturday night at the Marion County Fairgrounds.

Lasoski, who remains as the only winner here in the 410 c.i. sprint class this year, took two feature victories as he captured the regular main event plus a makeup feature which was rained out earlier in the season. The two wins paid the Missouri pilot \$5,000 and pulled him into a tie with Steve Kinser for third place with 40 career triumphs at this historic half-mile oval.

An estimated crowd of 7,000 saw Lasoski grab a third lap restart lead in the makeup feature to coast to a win of nearly half a lap. Marlon Jones claimed second, Max Dumesny took third, Brent Antill was fourth and Skip Jackson crossed the checkered for fifth. Garry Brazier, Terry McCarl, Ryan Jamison, Kevin Doty and Ricky Logan completed the top ten finishers.

In the second 20-lap feature, Lasoski again grabbed the lead on a restart, this time from McCarl after a sixth lap yellow. The “Show Me State” driver forged a quick trail through traffic to take the checkered ahead of Antill who managed a late race pass of McCarl. Fourth went to Dumesny and fifth was claimed by Danny Smith. Forming the top ten finishers were Logan, Randy Smith, Jones, Jerry Richert Jr. and Leonard Lee.

The Knoxville 360 c.i. sprints saw David Hesmer win that division’s first 15-lap feature event in track record fashion. Danny Young, Steve Wares, Scott Whitworth and Mike Twedt chased the former track champion to the stripe. In the second feature, Scott Whitworth became a first time winner as he led flag to flag. Young made a late pass to take second, Wayne Redmond claimed third, Terry Alexander was fourth and Twedt again finished fifth.

Numerous wrecks plagued the evening, as a track which was lightning fast at the outset changed to a dry-slick surface. No serious injuries were reported.

Rick Ferkel is Hall of Fame Legends Winner

Knoxville, IA – The “Ohio Traveler”, Rick Ferkel, proved he still had the right stuff as he captured the Sprint Car Hall of Fame Classic at the Knoxville Raceway Friday night. The sprint car event was held for drivers aged 50 or older as part of the National Sprint Car Hall of Fame Induction Weekend.

Ferkel, a 54 year-old Director of Operations for the World of Outlaws sprint car racing organization, started the 22-lap feature event in the fifth row and picked his way methodically through the pack. As the race approached the halfway point, Ferkel suddenly became a factor as he had moved into fifth place and began challenging the front runners.

Lap eleven saw a yellow flag fly and the field of cars was realigned in single-file order. On the restart, Ferkel quickly passed two cars and one lap later took the lead, which he held to the end. A red flag near the completion of the event did not slow down the Ferkel piloted Lasoski Motorsports machine as the Buckeye driver collected \$2,500 for his efforts.

The feature event was really two races as the front part of the race saw a heated battle between the front row starters, Jim McElreath and Earl Wagner. The twosome dueled the historic half-mile oval side by side for numerous laps with McElreath on the low side and Wagner up against the cushion. The lap eleven slowdown brought an end to that classic battle as Ferkel then moved into the fray.

Jerry Crabb, a regular driver at Knoxville in the 360 sprint division, drove a strong and heady race and took second position near the end of the event. Archie Ergenbright, another Knoxville regular, also made a late pass to claim third. McElreath finished fourth and Bill Utz took fifth. Rounding out the top ten positions were Cliff Woodward, Bob Thoman, Larry Dickson, Stacy Redmond and Lloyd Beckman.

Qualifying heat race events went to Shelby Steenson, Keith Hightshoe, Ferkel and Ergenbright. Allen Barr won the C main and Leroy Van Conett took the B main.

Lasoski Wins 6th Straight at Knoxville

Knoxville, IA – Danny Lasoski continues to be the hottest sprint car driver in the upper middle west as he captured his sixth feature event in as many starts at Knoxville Raceway. The latest win came aboard the Guy Forbrook prepared sprinter during an NCRA sanctioned stopover Saturday night at the Marion County Fairgrounds.

Lasoski and Terry McCarl traded positions for the first two circuits of the 20-lap feature event, until the “Show Me State” driver took control for good on the third go-around. However, McCarl was not to be denied as he stayed within shouting distance for the remainder of the race and in fact challenged briefly for the top spot on lap twelve.

On a track which had turned dry-slick, Lasoski and McCarl made the best headway through lap traffic on the high side of the half-mile oval. And in a race which went nonstop, each driver displayed remarkable passing skills when forging through lap traffic.

When the checkered flew at the end of the ten-mile event, Lasoski had garnered his 41st career feature win at this historic dirt track and was paid \$2,500 for his efforts. McCarl stayed in the second position to claim \$1,700, while Randy Smith took third after a late race pass of fourth place finisher Max Dumesny. Danny Smith finished strong to take the fifth spot. Jerry Richert Jr., Tim Monson, Bob White, Brent Antill and Dennis Moore Jr. completed the top ten finishers.

Danny Young captured his third feature of the season at Knoxville in the 360 c.i. sprint division. Forming the top five finishers were Walt Esch, Duane Van Heukelom, Daniel Coggeshell and Mike Twedt.

During afternoon ceremonies on the fairgrounds, the National Sprint Car Hall of Fame & Museum inducted fifteen new members into its prestigious hall. The fourth annual affair was attended by several hundred interested parties, dignitaries and honored guests.

At the conclusion of the evening’s racing activities, Director of Racing Ralph Capitani announced to the estimated crowd of 8,000 that he would offer Guy Forbrook, owner of the Danny Lasoski sprint car, an additional \$1,500 to win if Lasoski starts on the tail of next week’s feature event. Should the Forbrook/Lasoski team take the challenge, a feature event win could net a total of \$4,000.

Knoxville, IA – Danny Lasoski was back in victory lane at Knoxville Raceway Saturday night after a hard fought 20 lap chase involving last week's winner, Terry McCarl.

Lasoski, who has won eight features at this fairgrounds oval during the current season, enjoyed a pole position start and was quick out of the blocks, only to have a red flag for a single car accident bunch the field together again. McCarl fell in behind Lasoski when the green flew for the restart and the two drivers formed a nose to tail pair as they toured the Knoxville half-mile.

Both drivers were able to thread through lapped traffic flawlessly as several grooves appeared to work effectively for the front-runners. Danny Smith, Max Dumesny and Brent Antill stayed close to the front, but

were unable to mount a threat to the Lasoski-McCarl freight train. Dumesny eventually fell from the event shortly before the half-way mark.

The yellow flag flew with just five laps remaining and the trophy dash distance to the finish was not enough for McCarl to make a challenge of the Lasoski machine. The Missouri native stormed across the finish line to record his 43rd career feature event win, placing him in a tie for second place with Knoxville legend Earl Wagner. The win paid the Forbrook Motorsports team \$2,500 and reversed the order of finish to last week's feature for the two top runners.

Danny Smith, Brent Antill and B main transfer Aaron Berryhill formed the top five finishers. Completing the top ten were Skip Jackson, Randy Smith, Jaymie Moyle, Ricky Logan and Bob Weuve.

A crowd estimated at 9,000 witnessed Wayne Redmond capture his tenth career 360 c.i. sprint feature. The second generation driver grabbed the top spot when race leader Billy Bell dropped from the event. Scott Whitworth, Archie Ergenbright, Randy Martin and Tom Lenz rounded out the top five.

McCarl Wins Knoxville Pre-Nationals Feature

Knoxville, IA – Terry McCarl, driving a self-owned Maxim chassis, found his way back into the winner's circle Saturday night at the Knoxville Raceway in what could be termed a warm-up for the upcoming 33rd Annual Knoxville Nationals.

By most standards, the race was an odd affair as the final lap took more than a half hour to complete as yellow and red flags stopped and prolonged the completion of the event. Wrecks and attrition claimed half the field leaving just ten cars running at the checkered flags.

Six-time Knoxville track champion Randy Smith led the event from the outset and spent the entire ten-mile distance fending off the strong challenges of McCarl. The two drivers formed a nose to tail train and forged quickly around the half-mile oval until they encountered lapped traffic at the mid-race mark.

Though Smith was able to get by the backmarkers, McCarl kept the race interesting by staying right on his back bumper. Coming into the fray, Max Dumesny took McCarl on the final lap and had in fact passed Smith too, but a caution flag wiped out the valiant charge by the Aussie pilot and set the stage for the long-lasting final lap.

The final restart saw McCarl slide underneath Smith going into the first and second turns, as Smith jumped the cushion and Dumesny too made the pass. McCarl held the coveted top spot to the end to collect his eighth

career win at the Marion County Fairgrounds and received \$2,500 for his efforts. Dumesny was second, Smith held for third, Brent Antill was fourth and Aaron Berryhill, a B main transfer, took passing honors for fifth.

Rounding out the top ten finishers were Jaymie Moyle, Garry Lee Maier, Bob White, Fran Bruns, and Daniel Coggeshell. Current track points leader Danny Lasoski developed mechanical problems early in the B main and failed to qualify.

Wayne Redmond gained his second feature event win in a row in the 360 c.i. sprint division. The third generation driver led the distance and was followed to the line by Randy Martin, Billy Bell, Scott Whitworth and Tom Lenz.

Two Ohio Drivers Steal the Show in the Thursday Nationals Opener

The opening night of qualifications for the 33rd NAPA Knoxville Nationals saw “Buckeye State” natives Dave Blaney and Jac Haudenschild put on exciting driving exhibitions in front of a record crowd estimated at 17,000.

Blaney’s drive came with a \$3,500 win in the 20-lap non-stop feature event which closed out the first night of qualifications at 1:10 a.m. But before the “Buckeye Bullet” could even turn one lap, a four-car wreck eliminated hopefuls Ryan Jamison, Bobby Burrow, Bobby McMahan and Kevin Huntley.

When the race resumed, front row starter Bobby Davis Jr. grabbed the lead and set sail on the half-mile oval. Two laps later, Blaney was in the runner-up spot but nearly 20 car lengths behind the leader. When Davis entered lapped traffic on the seventh circuit, Blaney suddenly cut the margin considerably and by the ten-mile mark was running nose to tail with the Memphis driver. It was at this point that Steve Kinser, who had survived a heat race crash earlier in the evening, entered the picture too.

Lap eleven saw Davis and Blaney flash by the flagstand side by side as Blaney took the lead which he never relinquished. Kinser made a pass of Davis on lap fourteen and charged after Blaney but was never able to reel in the Ford-powered sprinter. At the finish line, it was Blaney by 20 car lengths, but Kinser’s 495-point total would guarantee the defending champion the pole position start in Saturday’s championship feature.

Jac Haudenschild provided the fireworks for the evening as his qualifying drives added to the lore of Nationals. After dropping out of his qualifying heat race while leading, he was forced to start on the tail of the C main, a new event added in 1993. From the tail of the 22-car field, he proceeded to finish second in the non-stop ten lap event. He then had the giant crowd cheering for more as he drove from last to runner-up in the green to checkered twelve-lap B main, passing three cars on the final lap. Again starting on the tail of the A main, he took passing honors with a tenth place finish.

A heavy downpour on Wednesday forced the first night of qualifications to be scrubbed and those cars would then be slated to try again on Friday. On Thursday, the pit area was still extremely wet, so a great many of the cars were pitted in the livestock barns just outside turn four as 71 cars signed in for the night.

The 20-lap feature event was red-flagged as quickly as it began when the sprinter of Jimmy Carr became airborne in turn four after climbing over the tire of another car. A complete restart was called for and when the green again dropped, pole sitter Jerry Richert Jr. led the charge into turn one and around the half-mile oval.

Lap five saw a second red flag incident when Steve Ballenger spun and the cars of Randy Nygaard and Marlon Jones came together and struck the Ballenger machine.

When the race resumed, Richert had quite a battle on his hands as Herrera had moved from his third row starting position to challenge for the lead. Lap after lap saw the Albuquerque driver place his newly built Jenkins chassis in a position to make a pass, but his bids were never successful until a move on the backchute on lap thirteen gained him the top spot. The move was all for nil as a yellow flag slowed the field of cars, reverting the lineup to the previous lap and giving the lead back to Richert.

On the restart, Herrera was again successful as he took the lead coming out of turn four and never looked back. Richert, who had damaged his nose win in a bumping incident during the yellow flag, continued to fall backward as his sprinter became difficult to handle on the afternoon track.

Trailing Herrera to the checkered flags were California teenager Blake Robertson, Kevin Frey and Rich Bubak. Randy Smith took passing honors for the afternoon as he drove from dead last to finish fifth. Skip Jackson, Richert, Lance Blevins, Ronald Laney and Kenny McCarl rounded out the top ten finishers.

The Race of States Feature and the Mystery Feature which are normally contested on Friday night were not run. Instead, the \$37,590 total purse from both events was divided evenly among all Nationals participants.

Kinser Races to Ninth Knoxville Nationals Title

“I’m as happy as I can be to win this race. It’s been a tough year,” summarized Steve Kinser as he spoke to the gathered members of the press shortly after winning the 33rd Knoxville Nationals. The twelve-time World of Outlaws champ had just won his ninth Knoxville crown in fourteen years, in what many would call his most hard fought Nationals win.

Kinser, whose title wins have come in sets of three (1980-81-82, 1986-87-88, and 1991-92-93) started on the pole of the championship race for the fifth year in a row. The Hoosier native dropped as far back as third before assuming control of the 30-lap event.

The thirty-third addition of the Knoxville Nationals was really two races. The first race, which pushed off at 11:40 p.m. with spitting rain coming down out of the skies, saw Kinser jump to the lead with cousin Mark Kinser in tow followed by Dave Blaney and Stevie Smith. Steve toured the first portion of the race with ease until Smith caught fire behind him.

On lap five, Smith disposed of Blaney as he suddenly found the fast line around the half-mile oval. He made his move on Mark two laps later and just as quickly reeled in Steve. With light rain falling, the giant crowd of 23,000 roared its approval as the 1989 Nationals rookie darted below Steve in turn two of lap eleven and took the lead. Kinser returned the pass on the next circuit and then Smith regained the point position again on the thirteenth go-around.

That was when the race was abruptly halted by a red flag as Terry McCarl, the only Iowan in the event, slammed into the front stretch fence. The drizzle, which had been falling throughout, now became heavier, forcing a near one-hour delay. During the stop, cars left the track and were allowed to change tires and make other changes.

“When that rain started, I’d already made the decision that if we rained out tonight, we were paying on 13 laps, and that would’ve been the 1993 Nationals,” Knoxville race director Ralph Capitani later said.

After the short shower the track was run in by push trucks and the sprinters were given a few hot laps before what could be called “the second race” resumed. On the restart, Mark was able to get by Steve to take second. After an intense battle, Steve reclaimed the lost position three laps later. Kinser then set sail and finally caught and passed Smith in the second turn of the twenty-first lap. Smith was able to stay within striking distance and pulled even on lap 28, but Kinser put a car between them, securing his position. Twice yellow flags slowed the race on the final lap, but on the restart of each new green, Kinser was able to pull away in the Karl Kinser No. 11 Valvoline Maxim to win the \$70,000 first place prize.

Smith claimed \$35,000 for the runner-up spot and Mark Kinser came home third for \$20,000 in a car suffering from motor problems. Jeff Swindell passed late in the event to take home the \$15,000 fourth place check, and Blaney received \$12,000 for his fifth place efforts. Andy Hillenburg, Danny Lasoski, Kenny Jacobs, Fred Rahmer from a twenty-second position start and Max Dumesny formed the top ten finishers.

Bringing the four-day \$400,000 classic to a close were four additional preliminary features. Winning the E main was second generation driver, Chad Mellenberndt, while Australian Peter Murphy took the D main. Sammy Swindell, who surprised many by reentering sprint car racing, captured the C main and Jac Haudenschild won the B main. The Best Appearing Crew award went to the Danny Lasoski team. Lance Dewease was named as Rookie of the Nationals for 1993.

Knoxville 360 Nationals Opener Goes to Kevin Frey

Knoxville, IA – Kevin Frey won the opening round of the Third Annual Knoxville 360 Nationals as he drove the Bob Trostle “house car” to a fifteen-lap feature event victory at Knoxville Raceway Friday night.

The Pennsylvania driver, who just recently picked up the driving chores for Trostle, held off a valiant charge from sixth-row starter Garry Lee Maier for a surprising win at this historic half-mile oval.

Mike Chadd jumped to the lead at the outset of the race from the pole position and held the top spot for ten circuits until a yellow came out for a stalled car. On the restart, Frey took advantage of his third place position and grabbed the point position as the field raced down the backstretch and into turn three. Maier, who is the defending champion of this race, fell in behind Frey but was unable to make a pass although he challenged for the position on every turn.

At the checkered, it was Frey over Maier by a narrow margin with Randy Martin taking a close third. Knoxville 360 points leader Danny Young finished fourth and Tommy Scott was fifth. Rounding out the top ten finishers in the 15-lap preliminary feature event were Tony Moro, Bob Thompson, Dwight Snodgrass, Steve Wares and Mike Chadd.

Maier was the class of the 74-car field in time trials and won his qualifying heat race as well. Other heat event victors were Frey, Young, Lee Nelson, Mike Twedt and Scott. Donald Lee Friesz was victorious in the C main and Matt Spies was the winner in the B main.

Several wrecks eliminated cars during qualifying heat races. Chris Walraven ran up over a wheel and lodged his car into the retaining wire by the back pit gate. Wayne Redmond and Kelly Rowe wrecked hard in turn four while trying to avoid striking a third sprinter. At the start of the B main, Brian Schnee and Reed Petersen took tumbles in separate incidents as the field of cars charged into turn three.

Drivers representing ten states qualified for the two-day event which has posted an overall purse of \$30,170.

Garry Lee Maier Repeats as Knoxville 360 National Champion

Knoxville, IA – Defending National Champion Garry Lee Maier swept to a resounding victory at Knoxville Raceway Saturday night during the 3rd Annual Knoxville 360 c.i. Nationals.

Maier, who pilots the Jimmie Rogers Jenkins chassis sprinter, sat on the pole of the 20-lap championship event by virtue of his 498 point score, and roared into the lead at the drop of the green flag. Knoxville 360 track champion Danny Young chased Maier from the outset from his row one starting spot and kept in close contact in the early portion of the event.

A yellow flag bunched the field of cars just prior to the halfway mark, but Maier was able to keep Young at bay when the race was restarted. When the track was free of traffic, Maier utilized the cushion in turns one and two and the low side through three and four. However, lapped traffic by the thirteenth circuit forced the fleet Kansan to change his preferred lines and Young began to slowly close the distance between the two front-running machines.

As the white flag flew, Young brought the crowd to its feet as he dove beneath Maier in the second turn to challenge for the lead. But Maier had the momentum and pulled past Young going down the backstretch and into turn three. The twosome exited turn four nose to tail and Maier was able to beat Young to the checkered by six-car lengths.

Maier received \$3,000 for his championship efforts and Young took home \$2,250 for his runner-up finish. Missouri stalwart Randy Martin ran third the entire race and was paid \$1,700. Todd Wessels claimed fourth and \$1,500 for the state of Minnesota, while Kevin Frey took home \$1,300 to Pennsylvania. Rounding out the top ten finishers were Lee Nelson, Bob Thompson, Dwight Snodgrass, B main winner Duane Van Heukelom and Tony Moro.

The B main for the 360 sprinters saw several reds as Curtis Thorson, Scott Whitworth, Ed Rotert and Kenny Williams all wrecked between turns three and four in separate incidents. The C main went flag to flag and was captured by Williams.

Danny Lasoski was crowned track champion as he swept to a win in the 25-lap feature event for 410 sprinters. The win was Lasoski's 44th at this half-mile oval and moved the "Show Me State" driver to second on the all-time list and just fifteen shy of Doug Wolfgang's mark. The victory was not an easy venture for Lasoski as the loss of a U-joint during qualifying time trials force "the Dude" to start in the ninth row of the feature event. The five-time track champion grabbed the top spot after a lap eighteen restart and never looked back in claiming the \$3,000 pay check. Lasoski also won an additional \$2,000 by capturing the Miller Beer Dash for Cash.

Young Mike Reinke led the first ten laps of the season championship feature until Ricky Logan took the top spot. The expiration of Logan's engine on lap eighteen bunched the cars and tail-end starter Danny Smith jumped into the runner-up spot where he finished behind Lasoski. Max Dumesny took third, tenth-row starter Brent Antill claimed fourth and Doug Wolfgang marked his return to Knoxville soil with a fifth place finish after a deep pack start.

Knoxville WoO Valvoline Classic Prelim to Stevie Smith

Knoxville, IA – Stevie Smith guided the Al Hamilton J&J sprinter to a 20-lap feature event win at the Knoxville Raceway Friday night during the World of Outlaws (WoO) Valvoline Classic.

Smith, who led the entire distance from his pole position, was challenged in the first portion of the event by fellow front row starter Dave Blaney. With Smith on the cushion, Blaney kept within ten-car lengths of the swift front-running car.

On the third circuit, third running Steve Kinser nearly struck the turn three fence and was himself nearly sideswiped by fourth running Mark Kinser. The incident allowed 1993 Knoxville Raceway track champion to get by and pick up the chase of Smith and Blaney.

A red flag came out on the eighth lap for Jimmy Sills, who suffered a single car wreck at about the same spot as where the Kinser incident occurred.

On the single file restart, Kinser was able to get by Lasoski, as was Mark Kinser, and the two Indiana drivers set a torrid pace in attempting to chase down the two front-running machines. The thirteenth circuit saw Steve Kinser get by Blaney in lapped traffic and begin an exciting pursuit of Smith in the closing laps of the event. Several times, the Kinser mount was able to sneak underneath the Smith machine, but the Keystone State pilot

was able to fend off all challenges to score his fourth career feature event win at this Marion County fairgrounds oval. Smith was paid \$3,500 for his winning efforts.

Kinser, who had won the August Knoxville Nationals ahead of Smith, finished five-car lengths behind to take second.
